QLC2021 Poster Presentation will be held for 2 hours, 12:30-14:30, on May 11 and 12, using "Remo" conference system. Showing the image data that each presenter pasted on Remo's Whiteboard, poster presenters explain their results and discuss them with participants, as in a regular conference poster presentation. For effective presentations at Remo, please follow the following guidelines.

About an hour before Poster Sessions, we will open Remo venue. To prevent troubles, please check the operation of Remo during this trial time.

Guidelines for preparation of your poster

- Size: (recommended) A0 [841 mm (33.1 inch) x 1189 mm (46.8 inch)]
 (Since posers will be projected on a PC screen, the landscape format is recommended. However, using the portrait format is not prohibited.)
- Create posters with image data such as JPEG and PNG. PDF and PPTX files are NOT allowed. Please confirm the visibility during the trial time.
- 3. Write your poster number in the upper left corner of the poster at 60 pt. or more. Please check your poster number in the program from the URL below. <u>http://qlc.jp/2020/11/26/qlc2021/</u> *program = TBA
- 4. At the top of your poster, write the title of your presentation, the authors' names and affiliations, and your e-mail address.
- 5. We recommend a minimum of 72 pt. for presentation title and 50 pt. for authors. Sans-serif fonts such as Arial and Gothic are recommended.
- All participants will be able to see the posters displayed. However, <u>do not download</u> <u>the posters</u>. The poster presenters must <u>lock the pasted data</u> so that it cannot be inadvertently manipulated by other participants.
- 7. We plan to set up the core times for the respective poster presentations so that poster presenters can see poster presentations by others. In this case, the audience may visit your poster presentation in your absence. Please make your poster understandable even if presenters leave their seats.

■ Notes for poster presentation

- For the trial time, we will open Remo venue before the time of Poster Presentation (Details will be announced later). In order to prevent troubles, please check the operation of Remo during this trial time.
- 2. In the poster presentation put on Whiteboard, you can check where the audience will pay attention as an icon. If necessary, enlarging the display.
- 3. We recommend that you have a face-to-face discussion with the <u>camera on</u>.
