The "1min. Preview" is intended as a promotional opportunity for the presenter to attract audiences. There is no specific instruction, but you are expected to summarize the content of your poster using one or two PowerPoint slides and briefly explain it to all participants within one minute at the venue, lecture room, ISSP.

After the "1 min. Preview", "Poster Presentation" will be held for 2 hours at lounge, ISSP. During your core time, please stay in front of your own poster board so that the judges and participants are able to talk with you.

- *Please write your name (underline the presenter if more than one name is mentioned), affiliation, job title or academic year at the top of your poster or in other easily recognizable places.
- *Please take your posters home with you and do not leave or dispose them at the venue.
